Sacrament of Reconciliation: Confessions are heard at 10:00 a.m. on Friday or by appointment.

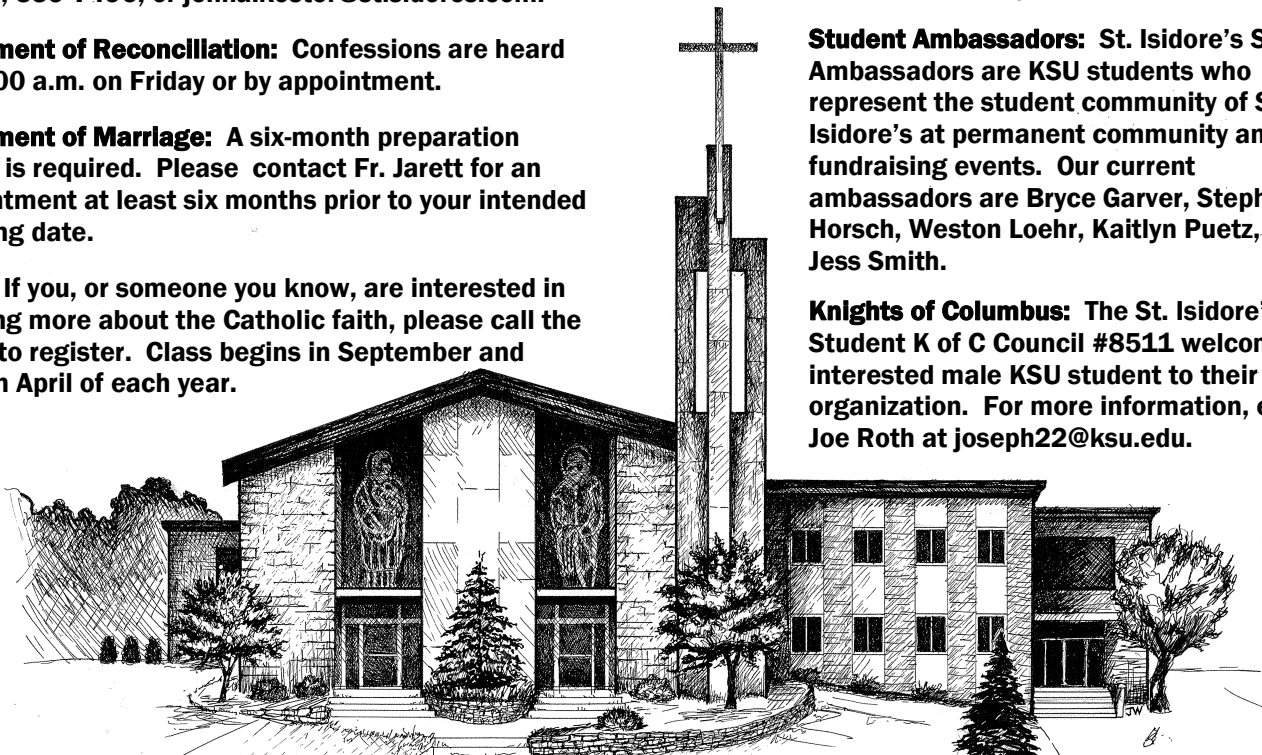
Sacrament of Marriage: A six-month preparation period is required. Please contact Fr. Jarett for an appointment at least six months prior to your intended wedding date.
