**RCIA:** If you, or someone you know, are interested in learning more about the Catholic faith, please call the office to register. Class begins in September and ends in April of each year.

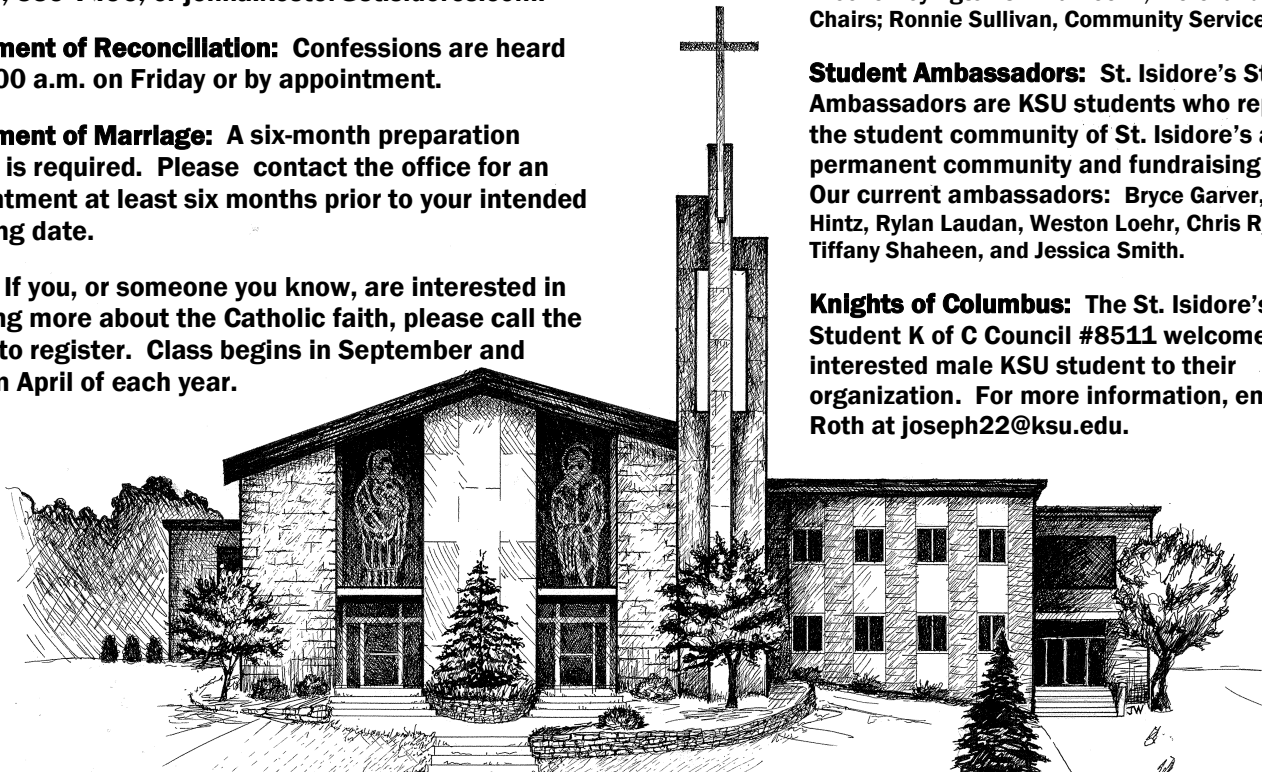

### Dear Friends,

*As we celebrate the Fourth of July, our Independence Day, it is important for us to realize that our lives are inter-dependent, we are related to one another. This is so evident in the Mystery of our being the Church, the Body of Christ through Baptism.*

*Fr Bob and I have appreciated your warm welcome as we arrived in your midst, unknown strangers at your door. We are both looking forward to being with you and together continuing to build up the vibrant community that is St. Isidore's.*

*Transitions are never easy. They require both a letting go and an openness, a farewell to what was and a welcoming of what is new. As Christians we are comforted in the midst of change by the virtue of Hope, God's promise to be with us, ego vobisco sum.*

*The Order of Preachers, also called Dominicans, was founded in 1216 by Dominic de Guzman, a contemporary of St. Francis. He was a priest of the diocese of Osma in northern Spain who accompanied his bishop on a mission for the Pope. In their travels they were made aware of the great hunger people had to better know their Catholic Faith so as to more perfectly love God and their neighbor. They worked in southern France combatting the Albigensian heresy which saw Creation as evil. Dominic continued this work and in time his vision was a novel one, to found an order of preachers who lived the common life, who prayed and studied, but who were itinerant, that is to say mobile, able to move from place to place.*

*Over time they grew and in 1216 we were established by Pope Honorius as the Order of Preachers. Fr Bob and I are part of that 800 year old tradition, and we are blessed to be called to serve in the diocese of Salina. Many of you may know the Dominican Sisters of Great Bend who have served throughout Kansas, they too are part of the Dominican Family, as well as cloistered Dominican nuns and the Dominican laity.*

*All of this is to let you know a bit more about these "new guys" and how pleased we are to be here with you.*
