RCIA: If you, or someone you know, are interested in learning more about the Catholic faith, please call the office to register. Class begins in September and ends in April of each year.

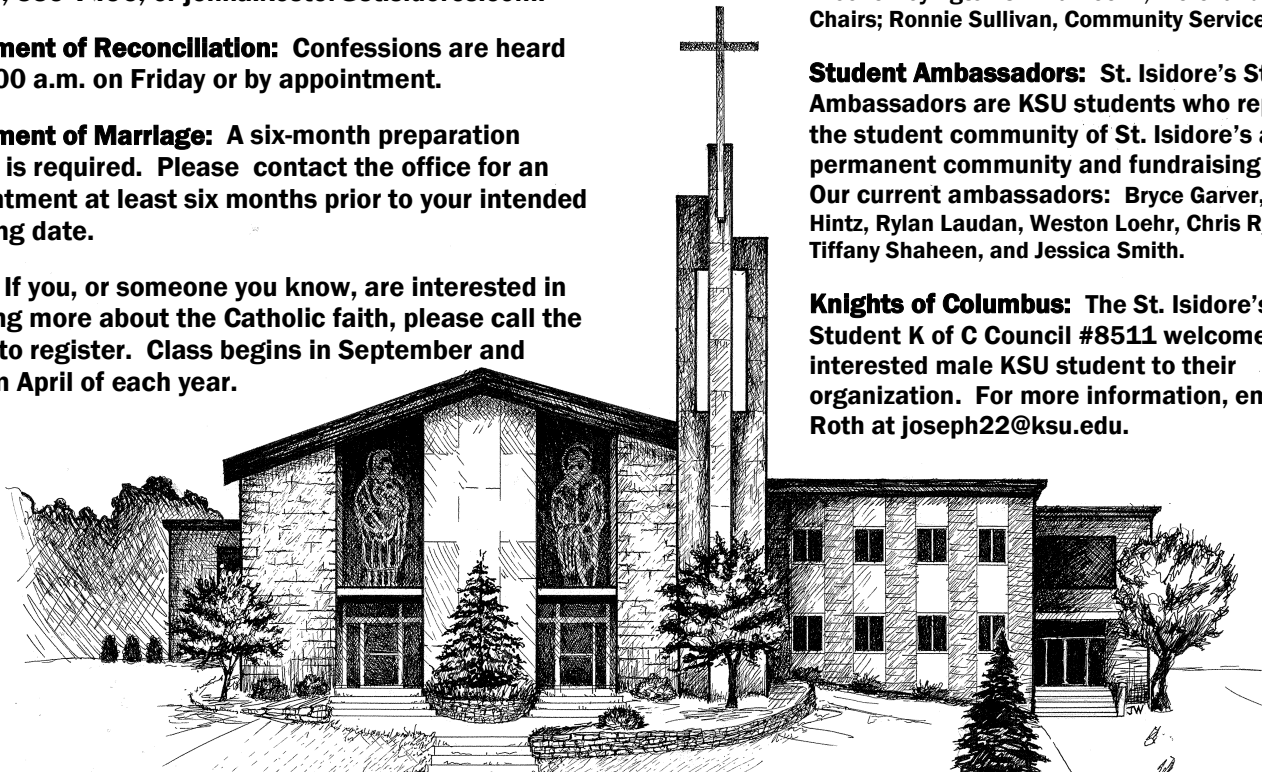

This Wednesday, July 22, is the feast of St. Mary Magdalene who followed Jesus and was one of the first to bear witness to the Resurrection. She truly was the proto-preacher of the Gospel. For this reason she has always been held as a patroness of the Order of Friars Preachers, or Dominicans. Fr. Bob and I wanted to take this weekend to say a bit more about the religious tradition of the Catholic Church we serve. Founded by the Spanish priest Saint Dominic de Guzman in France, the Order was approved by Pope Honorius III on December 22, 1216. Membership in the Order includes friars, nuns, active sisters, and lay or secular Dominicans. Founded to preach the Gospel and to correct the errors that lead to heresy, the teaching activity of the Order and its scholastic organization has placed the Preachers in the crossfires of contemporary culture and religion for over 800 years. Albert the Great, Thomas Aquinas, Catherine of Siena, Rose of Lima, Fra Angelico, Bartolomeo de Las Casas, Martin de Porres, Edward Schillebeeckx, Gustavo Gutierrez and Pier Giorgio Frassatti are all part of this legacy of St Dominic. In 2016 the Dominican Order will celebrate 800 years. This Jubilee Year of the Order coincides with the Holy Year of Mercy that Pope Francis has called the universal Church to celebrate.
