**RCIA:** If you, or someone you know, are interested in learning more about the Catholic faith, please call the office to register. Class begins in September and ends in April of each year.

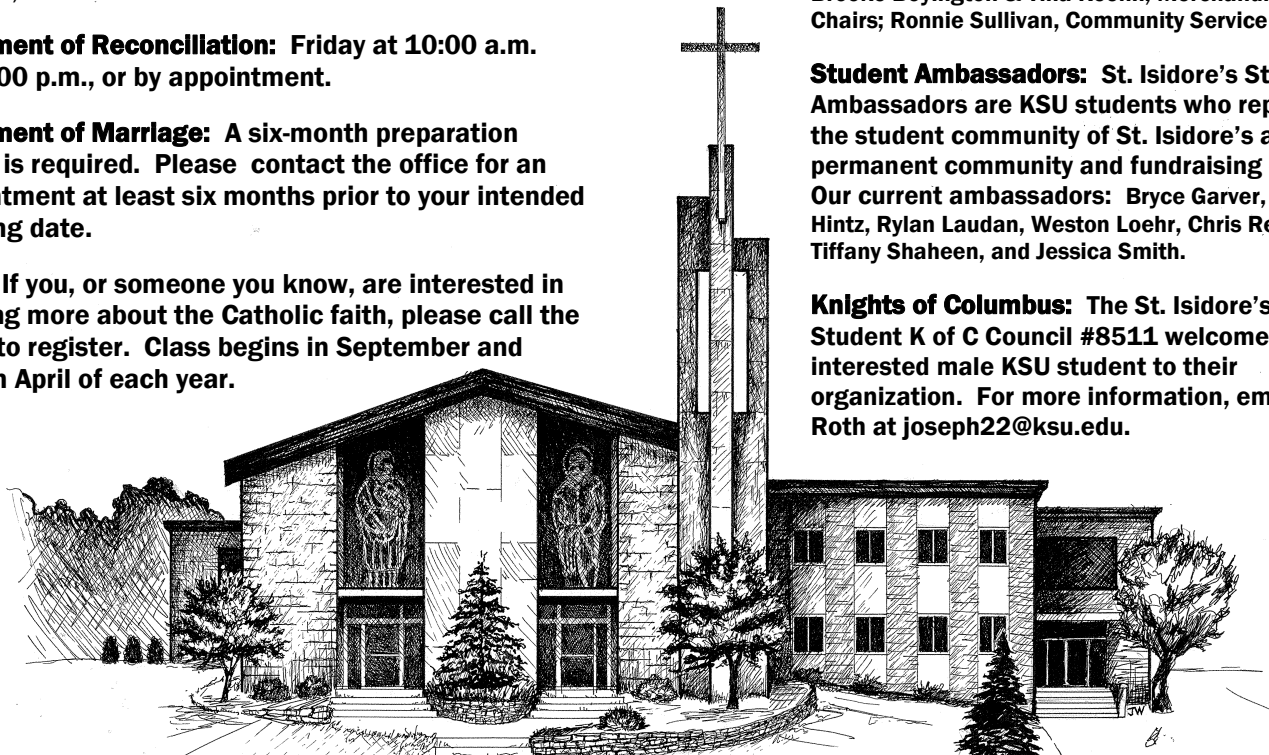

## Who is Robert Bellarmine and why is there a stain glass picture of him in our balcony?



It may be a surprise to some of you, but Saint Robert Bellarmine is a patron of our parish. When I received my letter of appointment from Bishop Weisenburger, it named me as "pastor of the parish of Saint Robert Bellarmine and the Catholic Student Center chapel of Saint Isidore's." This is interesting because it is part of the history of the Catholic presence here at Kansas

State University. The Jesuits who had a school not far from here would supply Masses for the Catholic students at K State. So we are fortunate to have two patron saints for our parish. And yes, we are a parish according to church law, we

are a "personal parish" (canon 518), our "congregation" is defined by the population of Kansas State University (students, faculty, staff, alumni and supporters), so we are a "university parish" (canon 813). There has been much confusion on this point, and I have consulted with Bishop Weisenburger who confirmed our canonical status.

Next week on the 17th of September, we will celebrate the feast of Saint Robert Bellarmine (4 October 1542 – 17 September 1621) who was an Italian Jesuit and a Cardinal of the Catholic Church. He was one of the most important figures in the Counter-Reformation. He was canonized in 1930 and named a Doctor of the Church. Bellarmine is also widely remembered for his role in the Giordano Bruno case and more infamously the case of Galileo. I found a fine reproduction of a 16<sup>th</sup> century portrait of our patron tucked away in a corner of the center which now hangs in our stair way coming down from the Fr. Keith Weber Education Wing. St. Robert looks to us as we descend the stairs, reminding us that "*the school of Christ is the school of love. In the last day, when the final exam takes place...Love will be the entire syllabus.*" -St Robert Bellarmine
