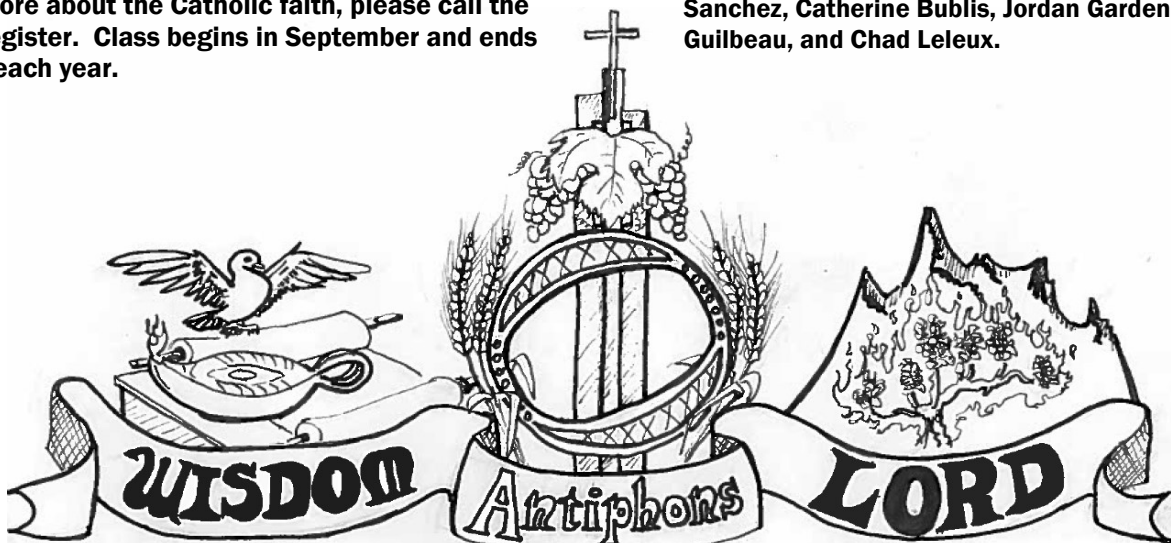

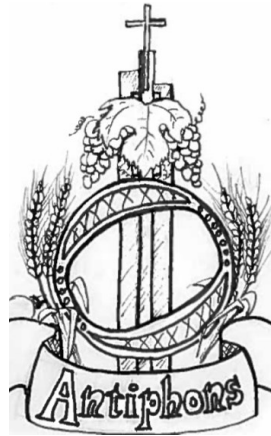

Most of us are familiar with the O Antiphons during the season of Advent because of the song “O Come, O Come Emmanuel.” This song uses five out of the seven traditionally known antiphons. The O Antiphons are used seasonally during Advent most commonly during the seven days before Christmas, from December 17 to December 24, in the Church’s *Liturgy of the Hours*. The antiphons anticipate the coming of the Lord by unfolding the mystery of the story of salvation history.

This season of Advent, our bulletin cover will feature two antiphons illustrated by Fr. Ryan McCandless each weekend. We will provide scriptural explanations of each of the antiphons here.

O Wisdom. Latin: *O Sapientia*.

Symbols: Dove, Lamp, and Scroll.

It is with the Wisdom of God that all creation was made.

O Wisdom, O holy Word of God, you govern all creation with your strong yet tender care. Come and show your people the way to salvation. Isaiah had prophesied, “The spirit of the Lord shall rest upon him: a spirit of wisdom and of understanding, a spirit of counsel and of strength, a spirit of knowledge and fear of the Lord, and his delight shall be the fear of the Lord” (Isaiah 11:2-3), and “Wonderful is His counsel and great is His wisdom” (Isaiah 28:29).

O Lord. Latin: *O Adonai*.

Symbols: Mountain and Burning Bush.

God revealed his name to Moses as the Great I AM.

O Adonai, O sacred Lord of ancient Israel, who showed yourself to Moses in the burning bush, who gave him the holy law on Sinai mountain: come, stretch out your mighty hand to set us free. Isaiah had prophesied, “But He shall judge the poor with justice, and decide aright for the lands afflicted. He shall strike the ruthless with the rod of his mouth, and with the breath of his lips he shall slay the wicked. Justice shall be the band around his waist, and faithfulness a belt upon his hips” (Isaiah 11:4-5); and “Indeed the Lord will be there with us, majestic; yes, the Lord our judge, the Lord our lawgiver, the Lord our king, he it is who will save us” (Isaiah 33:22).
